The regular monthly meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM, by Chairman Christopher Burdick. Also present were Harold Shay and Robert Finagan.

The minutes and treasurer's report were reviewed. On motion of Harold with Chris seconding and Bob in favor, the minutes were approved as written.

Harold gave his report as road master. They are getting ready to grade. They have been filling potholes.

Chris stated there was no COG meeting this last month.

William Shay thanked the Supervisors for all the work that has been done at the park. The dirt has been spread; the driveway is great. 15 to 20 people showed up for clean up. The paving of the basketball court was discussed, and it was decided to go with Harris paving. William stated that if anyone was wondering if taxpayer money was being used at the park, no it is not. We have been using Act 13 money.

Cindy had correspondence including a violation from DEP of a spill at 1815 Berg Hill Rd. Also, one change from the assessment office.

Chris explained the 30-day notice for a change of road name in Gibson. Church Road needs to be changed because there are 2 Church Roads in the 18847 zip code area,

Ken Chamberlain from Endless Mountain Heritage and Valerie Senese from Rails to Trails were present to ask the supervisors to sign a letter addressed to Penn DOT concerning a bike ride from the Starrucca Viaduct to the Nicholson Viaduct. They need a letter from each township that the bikers will be going through. After discussion, the supervisors signed the letter.

Clean Up day will be held June 4 from 9:00 AM to 1:00 PM. \$20 for a pickup truck or car. An ad will be put in the Shopping Guide.

Chris stated tht the Township- wanted to thank Tompkins Excavating for the work they did at the park, besides the driveway. They donated their time and equipment to spread the dirt on the field, excavate by the fish hatchery. They brought in a triaxle of mulch and topsoil to finish off by the new driveway, at no cost. It is all greatly appreciated.

Public Comment. Marilynne Twining stated she has seen many people using the nature trail at the park. Valerie Senese stated that she is from Susquehanna, but our park is a favorite for her and her children. Bridgette stated that we should have a community day this year at the park. Have a BBQ or covered dish picnic. Marilynne stated that she would be willing to help organize it. The supervisors approved.

All bills for the month were paid.
